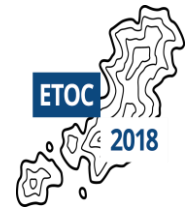

Rules / Fair Play



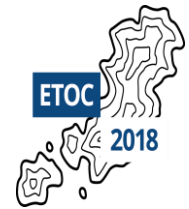
- “All participants shall behave with **fairness and honesty**. They shall have a **sporting attitude and a spirit of friendship**. Competitors shall **show respect** for **each other** and **naturally for the volunteers that facilitate the competition.**”
- Para eligibility - IOF certificate is required
- Using own assistant is allowed
- **Forbidden equipment**
 - Any kind of telecommunication device and computer
 - Binoculars and telescopes
 - Any kind of map of the competition area
- Permitted equipment
 - Compass
 - Watch (clock)
 - Odometer to assist measuring number of steps
 - Magnifying glass
 - Ruler
- **No deviations from IOF rules overall**

Punching and Result calculation



- **As at Model Events earlier today !!!**
- Remember **Clear – Check – Start**
- Remember to **punch** at each control
- Remember **Start - Finish** for **each section**
- Remember to bring the SI card to be read in **two (2)** read-out devices
- If You punch on the **backup paper card**, it is **mandatory** to report this to the marshall immediately at the finish of **each section**

Materials Delivery



- Solution maps shall be delivered in an envelope **only to a person with Team Official status** – at the **Event Centre of each competition**

Transport to



- For **both PreO** competitions the competitors will be transported to the Start/Quarantine area by two minibuses
 - one with capacity 8 people for Open category and walking Para competitors
 - the second with capacity 4+2 for wheelchair competitors
- **Get to the bus early enough** – there will be last minute rush otherwise
- = **Do not let the bus wait to be full**
- Walking is allowed, distances to Quarantine is 1,2 km both days
- Buses bring competitors back to Event Centre in the order they finish

Catering



- Pre-ordered meals are available at the Event Centre after competition
- At PreO 1 there is an additional possibility to buy some food at the Event Centre
- At PreO 2 there is not

Video and Voice recording



- Participants may be recorded by marshals, official photographers and active or passive cameras any time during the competitions
- Organizers plan to publish some photos, online and offline videos from the terrain and from ceremonies
- Organizers will decide publishing on their own option
- Organizers are committed to good habits and fairness when publishing
